MUSICOLOGICAL CONFERENCE MARCH 17-21, 2021

Geneva, December 27, 2020

Dear participants to the Conference,

We sincerely hope that this letter finds you in good health. Please find below an update about the Musicological Conference on the Syriac Musical Tradition, which we confirm will be held **from 17 to 21** March 2021.

In order to ensure everyone's health and safety in view of the current sanitary situation, and considering the difficulties of transportation and the current restrictions for obtaining visas, we took the decision to transform the Conference into a blended meeting, i.e. the Conference will take place both physically in Geneva and as an online videoconference using the Zoom platform. The concerts that accompany the Conference will be streamed from the different places where they will take place, in Europe and in the (Middle) East.

It was a difficult decision to take for us. In fact, we are highly aware of how important personal encounters are, and how such events held in presence facilitate them. However, we decided to privilege the possibility for all to participate in the current circumstances, and we look forward to rich and lively online debates. We will do our best to ensure a smooth technical context and implementation to the Conference.

Those of you who have to possibility to travel physically to Geneva remain of course most welcome. In that case, if you wish and are able to travel personally to Geneva, please kindly contact Giulia Valentini (giulia.valentini@hesge.ch) in the coming weeks to organize your travel and your stay in Geneva.

Date and time

The conference itself will take place from Thursday 18 to Saturday 20 March 2021.

An inauguration concert is scheduled on Wednesday 17 March 2021, with in principle daily concerts on 18, 19 and 20 March 2021, of 30 to 60 minutes each maximum, and final concerts taking place on Sunday 21 March 2021.

Time schedule for the conferences: Maximum 3 hours a day, considering the time difference between the different participants, from India to the United States.

A preliminary more precise draft time schedule is enclosed, and also refers to the time of the concerts.

Format of the conference (lectures)

Whether you are only attending online or you are (also) physically present in Geneva (in Geneva, we will gather in a room), we chose to limit the online speaking time of the lecturers, with a reduced intervention format, which has shown to be efficient and successful in other recent online events which we organized:

- We kindly ask you to provide us with your extended/full contributions (maximum 30 minutes or 5000 words) in writing or in prerecorded video format (or both, at your choice). These contributions will be distributed in advance to all participants, allowing them to read/visualize the material in advance.
- The Conference itself (lectures), from 18 to 20 March 2021, will be structured in intervention spots
 of 20 minutes each, including 5 to 10 minutes presentations by lecturers/contributors, followed
 by 10 to 15 minutes of questions and discussions.
- At the end of the Conference, contributions will need to be provided in final written publication format, and will be reviewed with open access by peers.
- The languages of the Conference are English and French. We will do our best to provide a simultaneous translation.

Submission of contributions

- Titles and abstracts. Most of them have already been handed over to us; We thank all those who have not yet provided their titles and abstracts, or who wish to correct them, to do so contacting xavier.bouvier@hesge.ch before 15 January 2021.
- Your contribution must be sent to us in advance before 28 February 2021 (ultimate deadline):
 - In written format (maximum 5000 words) to the following email address: xavier.bouvier@hesge.ch.
 - Alternatively, those of you who prefer to provide an oral contribution can send us pre-recorded videos of a maximum duration of 30 minutes. An online platform will allow you to record and/or transfer these videos. If you choose this option, please contact xavier.bouvier@hesge.ch for the technical aspects and the address of the online platform.
 - You may also provide your contribution both in written and video format.
 - **In the first days of March 2021**, the text and video contributions will be sent to all participants, so that they can read/view them in advance.

Copyright and personal data privacy rights

Copyrights and personal data privacy rights, as well as rights regarding one's own image, must be complied with. Distributed materials are drafts and may not be shared with third parties before their final publication. At the end of the Conference, you will be allowed time to complete or amend your contributions before the final publication in writing.

Our debates will be public (the interested public will be able to connect online, in principle without a possibility to intervene), but the contributions will not be shared outside the restricted circle of active participants (the publication at the end of the Conference, after a review by peers, will be public).

To facilitate the understanding of the public, your 5 to 10 minutes presentation during the conference should introduce/present the keys points of your full written/video contribution.

We are sure that the Conference will be very captivating also in this online format, and we look forward to your active participation.




